Many of us enjoy the convenience of automatic withdrawals for online purchases or to take care of items such as utility bills or car insurance. St. Paul's is pleased to offer this automated giving program to our parishioners. You can now have your contributions given automatically to St. Paul's Parish from your checking or savings account on a monthly basis.

Automatic withdrawal is secure, flexible and convenient. How often have you gotten to Mass and realized you left your envelope at home, or been gone for a weekend and went to Mass out of town? This method of giving will help St. Paul's have a more even income stream throughout the year. To enroll, simply complete the authorization form (found in the back of church, or at the rectory), place it in the collection basket with a voided check, or return the form to the church office.
