THE 2017/18 DIOCESAN ANNUAL APPEAL supports the Bishop's Office and the seminary formation, etc. It replaces 14 "second collections" during the year that support charitable causes. St. Paul's has directly received \$26,317.44 in school support last year along with educational Beet Grants. If we exceed our goal of \$55,620.00, it comes directly back to St. Paul's parish. **We have \$51,085.00 and are in need of \$4,535.00 to meet our parish goal. Currently 29% of parishioners have donated.** If you have already donated, we thank you. MEET MARY IN PRAYER



During this month of May, take some time and reflect on the prayer that comes to us from Mary's cousin Elizabeth, the Hail Mary. As you pray, flesh out the picture mind with thoughts of women you know who reflect Mary in their lives. They may help you appreciate Mary even more than you already do.

Begin your prayer by greeting Mary as you would a dear friend. "Hail Mary!" And as you go on with the words of your prayer, reflect on the following ideas:

- Full of Grace - Think of some women you know who makes you feel she is all beautiful inside, full of all that is good, bursting with God's life.
- The Lord is with you - Who are some women who have made you feel closer to God throughout the years of your life because they were so close to Him?
- Blessed are you among women - Who are the women you admire most, who make you feel your own goodness?
